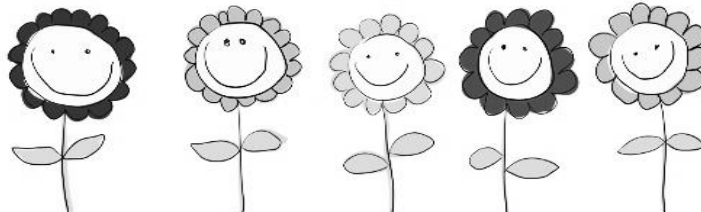
- ❖ Wednesday May 22nd

We ask that all children arrive by 10:00a.m. at Panthorn Park. Please be prompt, so we can begin on time.

- ❖ **DROP-OFF IS AT THE PARKING LOT NEXT TO THE POND BEHIND THE TENNIS COURTS**
(When you enter the park, drive down the road and you will see the picnic area, pond, and tennis courts on the left.)
- ❖ **PICK-UP WILL BE AT THE PLAYSCAPE.** (Playscape is on the right, across from tennis courts.)
- ❖ **We will be walking on a trail in the woods~ please dress for a hike.**

If you check off that you plan to accompany the class, you will automatically be placed on the chaperone list. There is no limit to the number of chaperones.

To Panthorn Park: (GPS Address = 485 Burritt St., Plantsville)

From Hartford: Take I-84 West to Exit 28 (Meriden-Waterbury Rd./Route 322). At the end of ramp, turn right onto Meriden-Waterbury Road. Go to the next light and turn left onto Ruggles Row. Continue to a stop sign and turn left onto Burritt Street. Go over the I-84 overpass, continue downhill about ¼ mile and the entrance to Panthorn Park will be on your right.

From Waterbury: Take I-84 East to Exit 28 (Meriden-Waterbury Rd./Route 322). At light, go straight across to Ruggles Row. Continue to a stop sign and turn left onto Burritt Street. Go over the I-84 overpass, continue downhill about ¼ mile and the entrance to Panthorn Park will be on your right.
